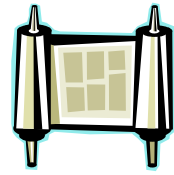


# *Celebrant's Guides: Psalms and Canticles*

### Settings of the *Magnificat*

- ▶ The text is set as Responsorial Psalm (mixture of 2, 4 and 6 line strophes) on p. 31 of '[The Baptism Book](#)' from Redemptorist Publications.
- ▶ The canticle text can be used with any suitable plainchant.
- ▶ There are also many metrical settings.
